- **Gas Pipelines**
 - 57,000 km (35,500 mi) wholly owned
 - 11,500 km (7,000 mi) partially owned
 - 250 Bcf of regulated natural gas storage capacity
 - Average volume of 14 Bcf/d
- **Oil Pipelines**
 - Keystone* 1.1 million Bbl/d
- **Energy**
 - 19 power plants, 10,800 MW
 - Diversified portfolio, primarily low-cost, base-load generation
 - 130 Bcf of non-regulated natural gas storage capacity

* Phases 1 and 2 in operation, Phases 3 and 4 in development

CGA Damage Estimates 2005-2010

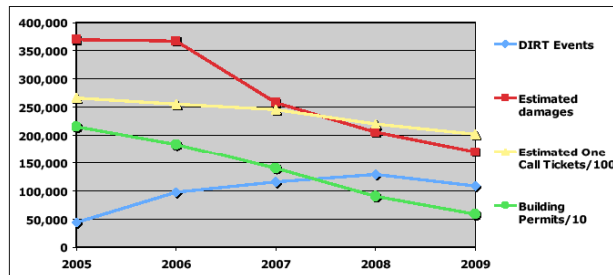
